Free trauma-informed, socially prescribed chair and mat-based yoga and meditation classes for people in recovery from drug and alcohol addiction, and people affected by a family member's addiction issues.

WHO

Classes are for people who are in recovery from drug and alcohol addiction. (Recovery does not need to mean abstinence from all substances but attendance under the influence will not be accepted). Classes are also open to people affected by a family member's addiction issues. Unsuitable for people in active psychosis.

WHAT

1 x weekly chair yoga class for people with limited mobility/comorbid health conditions or able bodied people who want to take it gently

1 x weekly mat-based yoga class for people a little more physically able (Both classes suitable for absolute beginners with optional time for refreshments and chat at the end)

Chair Class - Weekly on Fridays at 10.30 - 11.45am The Health Agency, (green reception) at The Healthy Living Centre

> Mat Class - Weekly on Wednesdays at 1.00-2.30pm The Community Wellbeing Space, Westside Plaza
